Family Commitment Statement

1. We as parent(s) or guardian(s), accepting God's responsibility which says "Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old, he will not depart from it," (Proverbs 22:6), do affirm that this training is carried on in the home. We promise that the home will provide a secure haven of safety, free from the very influences that we recognize as harmful.
2. We have carefully examined the Statement of Faith and agree with the Christian purpose of Faith Christian School and desire the school to work with us in the total education of our children.
3. In full cooperation with Faith Christian School, we will attend the functions requiring our participation.
4. We pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of Faith Christian School and will bring any criticisms directly to the administration so that those in authority may properly deal with them.
5. The teachers and administration are given full discretion in the discipline of our children, including corporal punishment, within the guidelines stated in the Family Handbook.
6. We pledge that if for any reason our child does not cooperate with the disciplinary standards of Faith Christian School, we will withdraw him/her without delay and will cooperate with the administration to make the withdrawal as quickly as possible, avoiding discussion with those not involved, so as to avert a spirit of dissension and division at either our child's expense or the school's. FCS reserves the right to discipline, suspend or dismiss any student who does not adhere to the standards stated in the Family Handbook. New students are accepted on a trial basis for the first grading period.
7. The School agrees to work closely with the parents or guardians in helping the students to learn to solve their school-related problems. This will include provision of competent teachers, a full and balanced curriculum, regular reporting, supervision of the children and the program, and cooperation with the home.
8. We understand that Faith Christian School is a ministry operating on the principle of faith. Tuition is kept as low as possible to make Christian education available to those who desire it for their children. Tuition and fees do not cover all operating costs. Additional funds and needs must be met with gifts and personal services of our parents. We ask that each parent purpose to give, as God provides, to meet the financial needs; to perform services when needed; and to uphold FCS consistently in family prayer.
9. We understand that we have a binding financial obligation for all fees, including tuition. Should a withdrawal during the year become necessary, tuition will be subject to an early withdrawal fee as outlined in the Family Handbook. We understand that delinquent payment could result in our student being dismissed from school.

Faith Christian School Statement of Faith

- WE believe** the Bible to be the verbally inspired and only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God. (II Tim. 3:16, II Pet. 1:21)
- WE believe** that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:1, John 10:30, John 10:37,38)
- WE believe** in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (Isaiah 7:14, Matt. 1:23, Luke 1:35, Heb. 4:15, Heb. 7:25, John 2:11, Heb. 9:12, Col. 2:14, John 11:25, Acts 1:11, Rev. 19:11, 16)
- WE believe** that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men. Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who was a pattern of the one to come. But the gift is not like the trespass. For if many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many! (Romans 3:23, Romans 5:12-15, John 3:5,18)
- WE believe** all are justified (acquitted of sin, declared righteous) as a gift by His grace through the redemption that is in Jesus Christ, whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation (payment of sin debt, an atoning victim) in His blood through faith. (Romans 3:24, 25)
- WE believe** that regeneration by the Holy Spirit, through Christ our Savior, is essential and an absolute necessity for his salvation (Romans 3:19, 23; John 3:16,19; John 5:24; Eph. 2:8,10; Titus 3:5,6)
- WE believe** in the continuing ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life. (Eph. 5:18, Eph. 4:30, I Cor. 3:16, I Cor. 6:19,20)
- WE believe** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they who are saved into eternal life and they who are lost unto eternal damnation. (John 5:28,29)
